- Summary of Findings: 68% of participants rated themselves an "A" or "B" in intellectual self confidence ability before taking the seminar, compared with 90% after taking the seminar
 - 57% of participants rated themselves an "A" or "B" in having no fear of speaking up in face-to-face conversations with 83% rating themselves that way at the conclusion of the seminar.
 - Before the seminar, 76% strongly or moderately agree that they possess the necessary personal qualities (e.g. responsibility, consideration, initiative, etc.) to be a successful career person, with 90% feeling that way after the seminar was completed

Impact of The assessment results demonstrate a true learning for all outcomes in this seminar. Students have showed a great **Assessment:** improvement in intellectual self confidence.

Lessons Learned: We will update our Pre and Post test that actually ask questions about professional communication (i.e. interview, communicating with authority, resume writing and cover letter).
