What is the *A* Program?

A is a multidisciplinary education program comprised of a series of workshops on topics related to alcohol use and abuse. This is an exciting opportunity to consider critically how alcohol abuse may impact individuals, relationships and communities. The workshops are available to all currently-registered UC San Diego students, including graduate and professional students. Students who complete four of the *A* Program workshops offered will receive a certificate of completion. *A* is not offered for academic credit.

Why should I participate?

- To develop a deeper understanding of an issue encountered by many professionals, including medical and public health professionals, mental health professionals and counselors, social workers, educators, attorneys, law enforcement officers and community leaders.
- To explore with professionals and other students how multiple disciplines may take similar, overlapping or differing perspectives on the same societal concern
- To earn a certificate that demonstrates your commitment to learning more about alcohol-related topics

What requirements must be met to receive a certificate?

Students must attend four one-hour workshops. Students will receive a program guide which describes all of the workshops offered when they submit their sign-up materials. Students will have the presenters initial their program guides at the end of each workshop they attend to verify attendance. Students must also fill out pre- and post-program questionnaires in order to receive their certificates.
